PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Grades 7–8 program prepares students academically, socially, and emotionally for a confident transition to high school. With small classes, enriched curriculum, specialist teachers, and meaningful leadership opportunities, students gain independence, strong work habits, and the skills needed to thrive in upper grades and beyond.

HIGH SCHOOL PREP

Students learn how to manage workloads, use planners, create study schedules, take exams, collaborate effectively, and advocate for themselves. Teachers, the Resource Team, and administration support families with high school applications, specialized program information (IB, AP, AAEP), and transition planning to ensure a smooth entry into Grade 9.

ENRICHMENT & LEADERSHIP

Grades 7–8 engage in enriched academics, hands-on STEM, the arts, and outdoor education that builds teamwork and resilience. As the oldest students, they lead House Teams, mentor younger peers, and take on roles that grow confidence and responsibility.

STUDENT WELL-BEING

Daily check-ins, SEL lessons, quiet workspaces, study hall, and personalized support help students build resilience, independence, and healthy habits while feeling supported in a caring community.
